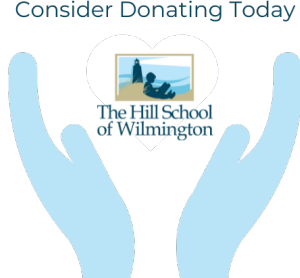


Dyslexia Superpowers
