SCHOOL DAY TUTORING AND ACADEMIC COUNSELING PROGRAM 2026-2027

Hill students may be able to receive Science and Social Studies instruction during the other half of their day here along with academic counseling in study skills. Each family whose child participates in this program must [register as their own homeschool program](#) and provide proof of that registered homeschool entity prior to participation in the program. Parents then use the grades and attendance data provided by our tutoring to enter into their homeschool reporting. Students in this program do not attend another "base school." Any other programming that might be required for homeschool guidelines, such as any electives or "specials" classes (art, music, PE, etc.) is not being offered through this program.

Enrollment is only for current HSW students and must be approved by the Executive Director. There are up to 7 students in each instructional group.

Students who receive Hill instruction in the morning stay until 1:50 PM; after their morning Hill session, they have lunch/break and then the science and social studies instruction. Afternoon Hill instruction students start at 8:50 AM with the science and social studies tutoring session, have lunch/break, and then have their regular Hill session in the afternoon. Breaks are scheduled throughout the session, including outdoor time.

The curriculum includes direct instruction, reading materials appropriate to each student's reading level, interactive lessons, and videos. It is taught in multi-age groups by an experienced, certified teacher. Some lessons include instruction and counseling in study skills: organization/planning, intentional focus, note taking, test preparation, and time management.

Tuition is \$7500 for the year. The program runs on all the days that the regular HSW session is operating.
